

**CAPITAL RADIO NETWORK
2CA's \$100 Grand for Canberra
TERMS & CONDITIONS**

These contest rules apply to the "2CA's \$100 Grand for Canberra" radio contest.

1. THE PROMOTER:

"2CA's \$100 Grand for Canberra" is a Capital Radio Network contest, conducted on radio station 2CA Canberra.

2. WHO MAY ENTER:

All entrants must be 18 years or older and reside in the ACT or NSW.

- You are ineligible to enter a competition if:

- I. you are an employee of, or contractors to, the Promoter or any of its agencies involved with this competition; or
- II. you are the spouse, de facto spouse, parent, natural or adopted child, and sibling (whether natural or adopted by a parent), of such employees and contractors (whether or not they live in the same household).
- III. you have won a prize/prizes valued either individually or collectively at more than \$100 from the Promoter or in any contest run by the Promoter in the prior 30 days.
- IV. you have been discovered to have used or attempted to use any more than one name in order to qualify to win any contest run by the Promoter except in the case of a legal change of name.
- V. you have won a prize valued at \$1,000 or more from the Promoter or in any contest run by the Promoter in the prior 90 days.
- VI. you have won a prize valued at \$5,000 or more from the Promoter or in any contest run by the Promoter in the prior 12 months.
- VII. you are an employee of any broadcast station within NSW, ACT, VIC or WA.
- VIII. you have been an employee of the Promoter within the last 60 days.

All contestants acknowledge that the Promoter can rely on Clause 2 and even if the Promoter only learns of a person's ineligibility after the Promoter has appeared to award the prize to the ineligible person. Return of the prize or payment of its value to the Promoter can be required by the Promoter if this occurs.

3. METHOD OF ENTRY

2CA's \$100 Grand for Canberra is a game of skill. Contestants enter by listening for one of the 10 winning songs played each day between 6am and 6pm Monday to Friday on 2CA during the active contesting period between 10 June 2024 and 21 June 2024 and phoning the studio contest line on 02 6241 1053 when it is played. 2CA will accept the 10th caller who will receive an invitation to attend a special major prize event on Saturday 22 June 2024 at a venue to be confirmed. A total of 100 contestants will be selected in this manner. At the special major prize event, the 100 contestants will be placed in a draw from which one contestant only will be selected as the single contestant who will have a chance to win \$100,000.

4. SPECIAL MAJOR PRIZE EVENT

The Special Major Prize event will be held on Saturday 22 June 2024 at the Jerrabomberra Hotel, 2 Limestone Drive, Jerrabomberra NSW 2619. Contestants are required to register their attendance at the venue between 10am and 11.30am in order to be included in the draw. The draw will take place at 12 noon and the selected contestant must be present in order to participate. No contestant shall be permitted to nominate any other person to participate in their place.

- 100 promotional envelopes will be prepared numbered 1 to 100
- Only one envelope will contain the major prize valued at \$100,000
- Ninety-nine envelopes will contain no prize
- All promotional envelopes will be the same size, colour, shape, weight and texture.
- A control envelope will be held by the promoter which contains the identity of the winning envelope and which will only be opened if the major prize is not won.
- The 100 promotional envelopes will be displayed in a designated area visible to the contestant and others so all can see the envelopes numbered 1 to 100.
- There will only be one contestant and that contestant will only have one chance.
- The contestant is not to touch, inspect, shine a light upon or interfere in any way with any of the envelopes.
- The contestant is to choose one envelope and open that envelope in front of the promoter and other attendees so it is visible to all.
- The promoter will film in a continuous sequence, the contestant choosing an envelope and the opening of the envelope.
- Should the contestant upon opening the envelope happen to choose the major prize valued at \$100,000 the promoter will collect further information to verify the win.
- Should the major prize valued at \$100,000 be won, the promoter will immediately collect all envelopes and return them to the contest insurer (MJM Corporate Risk Services) to verify that only one envelope was opened and none tampered with.
- Should the envelope with the major prize valued at \$100,000 not be won, the promoter will open the control envelope and then go to the winning envelope, open that envelope and show the contestant where the winning ticket was located to verify that indeed a prize valued at \$100,000 was offered.
- The promoter will confirm any win with its insurer and underwriter upon receipt of the returned envelopes within 48 hours of receipt and should the win be verified, make arrangements with the contestant for delivery of the prize.

5. PRIZE COLLECTION:

- I. The promoter may request at its sole discretion a winner to present in person to validate their identity by providing ID which includes a photograph.
- II. Upon request by the Promoter a copy of the general contest rules and/or a signed receipt and acknowledgement must be signed and endorsed by any winner to indicate his/her understanding and acceptance of these terms.
- III. Prizes will only be awarded following winner validation and verification to the satisfaction of the promoter.
- IV. The judges' decision is **final**, and no correspondence will be entered into.

6. PUBLICITY:

Acceptance of a prize constitutes permission for the Promoter to use winner's name, suburb of residence, recording of winner's voice and likeness for advertising and promotional purposes without compensation, unless otherwise prohibited by law.

7. EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY:

The Promoter takes no responsibility for the loss of prizes due to incorrect or imprecise delivery details provided by an entrant. The Promoter makes no representations or warranties as to the quality/suitability/merchantability of any of the goods/services offered as prizes. To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter is not liable for any loss suffered or sustained to personal property and including, but not limited to, consequential (including economic) loss by reason of any act or omission, deliberate or negligent, by the Promoter, or its servants or agents, in connection with the arrangement for supply, or the supply, of any goods or services by any person to the prize winner(s) and, where applicable, to any persons accompanying the winners.

8. OWNERSHIP OF ENTRIES:

- I. all entries (whether in written, audio or visual form, or a combination of those) become and remain the property of the Promoter (subject to the limits contained in the Privacy Statement).
- II. all winners' names and contact details will be kept on record, including the prize value awarded to that person.

9. DISQUALIFICATION:

- I. the Promoter is not responsible for lost, interrupted communications or unavailable network server or other connections, failed telephone, mid-delivery or computer transmissions or other errors of any kind, whether human, mechanical or electronic.
- II. the Promoter assumes no responsibility for any error, defect, delay, theft or unauthorised access to or alternation of entries. Subject to any written directions given under the applicable law, if for any reason, the competition is not capable of operating as planned, including infection by computer viruses, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, or proper conduct of the competition, then the –Promoter reserves the right, at its sole discretion,

to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this competition. The Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual for:

- a. tampering with the entry process, including exceeding any limitation on the numbers of entries, or any other process as determined by the Promoter that in any way affects the fairness of the promotion;
- b. tampering with the operation of the competition or web site;
- c. acting in violation of these terms and conditions;
- d. acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner; or
- e. if an entrant selected as winner is found to be in breach of paragraphs 3 or 4 of these conditions of entry, a new winner may be selected and, in the event that the entrant in breach has been awarded a prize, the entrant may be required to return the prize or reimburse the value of the prize to the Promoter.

10. PARTICIPATION:

Participation in the competition constitutes the entrant's unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these General Competition Entry Rules. These rules may change from time to time. The Entrant is responsible for ensuring his or her familiarity with the General Competition Entry Rules at the time of participation. The Promoter's decision not to enforce a specific restriction does not constitute a waiver of that restriction or of the General Competition Entry Rules generally.

11. DURATION OF THE PROMOTION

2CA's \$100 Grand for Canberra will commence on Monday 10th June 2024 and will conclude at 6pm on Friday 21st June 2024. The Special Major Prize Event shall take place between 10.30am and 12.30pm on Saturday 22nd June 2024.
